



Donnybrook apprentices shine

DONNYBROOK apprentices are continuing to shine when pitted against others of their trade from around the state.

Jessamy Mooney, a first-year apprentice at Donnybrook's Salon de Coiffure, won third place in the hair-dressing division of the competition.

Her win follows the success of fellow hairdresser Alexis Scott, who came third in the international heat of the competition last month.

Jessamy said the competition involved doing a ladies' cut, colour and blow dry, a men's cut and blow

dry and then a copy of a "hair up" on a mannequin.

She competed against eight other state finalists.

"It was a good experience, I learned a lot and will go in it again next time," she said.

Donnybrook boy Cameron Green, an apprentice fitter and turner for D&R Machining in Bunbury, also competed at World Skills – and won gold.

He will go on to represent WA at the national level in South Australia.
